The above positions are combined with faculty positions at the appropriate rank commensurate with experience and track record at the post-graduate School of the Institute.

The successful candidates will be accountable to the Chief Executive Officer and Medical Director and they will be members of the Institute's Scientific Council.

- An MD degree with a sub specialty in Neurology; and
- Recognized board certification in Neurology; and
- License or eligible for license from the Pancyprian Medical Association; and
- A minimum of 6 years of post-graduate training and experience in an accredited medical centre; and
- Knowledge of clinical operations and procedures; and
- Supervisory experience; and
- Command of the Greek and English languages; and
- Ability to designing and carrying out original independent research programs; and
- Demonstrated track record and commitment to research with peer reviewed publications.

Experience in one of the fields relevant to the activities of the Institute's Neurological Centres (Neuromuscular Disorders, Multiple Sclerosis and Related Disorders, Movement Disorders, Dementia, and Epilepsy) will be considered an advantage.
